

# FINDING YOUR RING SIZE

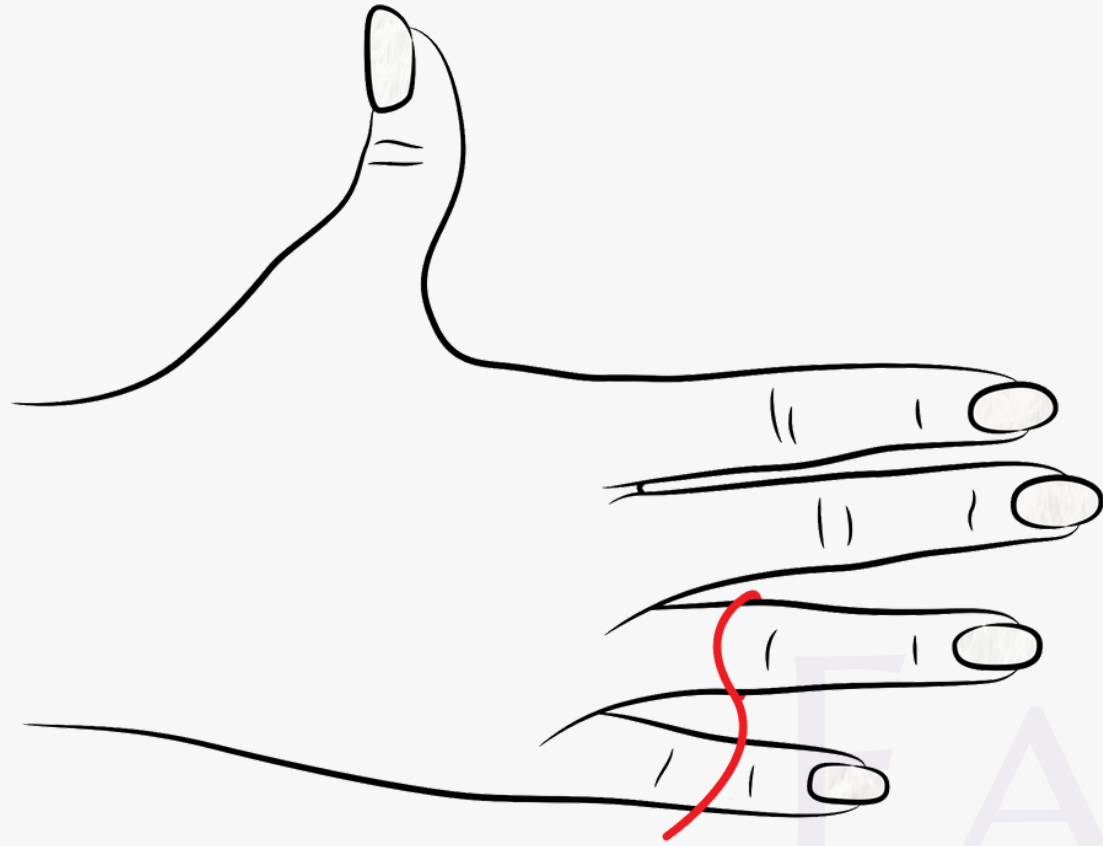
## Method 1: Using an existing ring



- Choose a ring that already fits your finger well
- Measure the inner diameter of the ring in Millimetres (mm)
- Once you have the mm, use the measurements given in the “RING SIZE CHART” and provide it as a reference to our executives or select on the website.

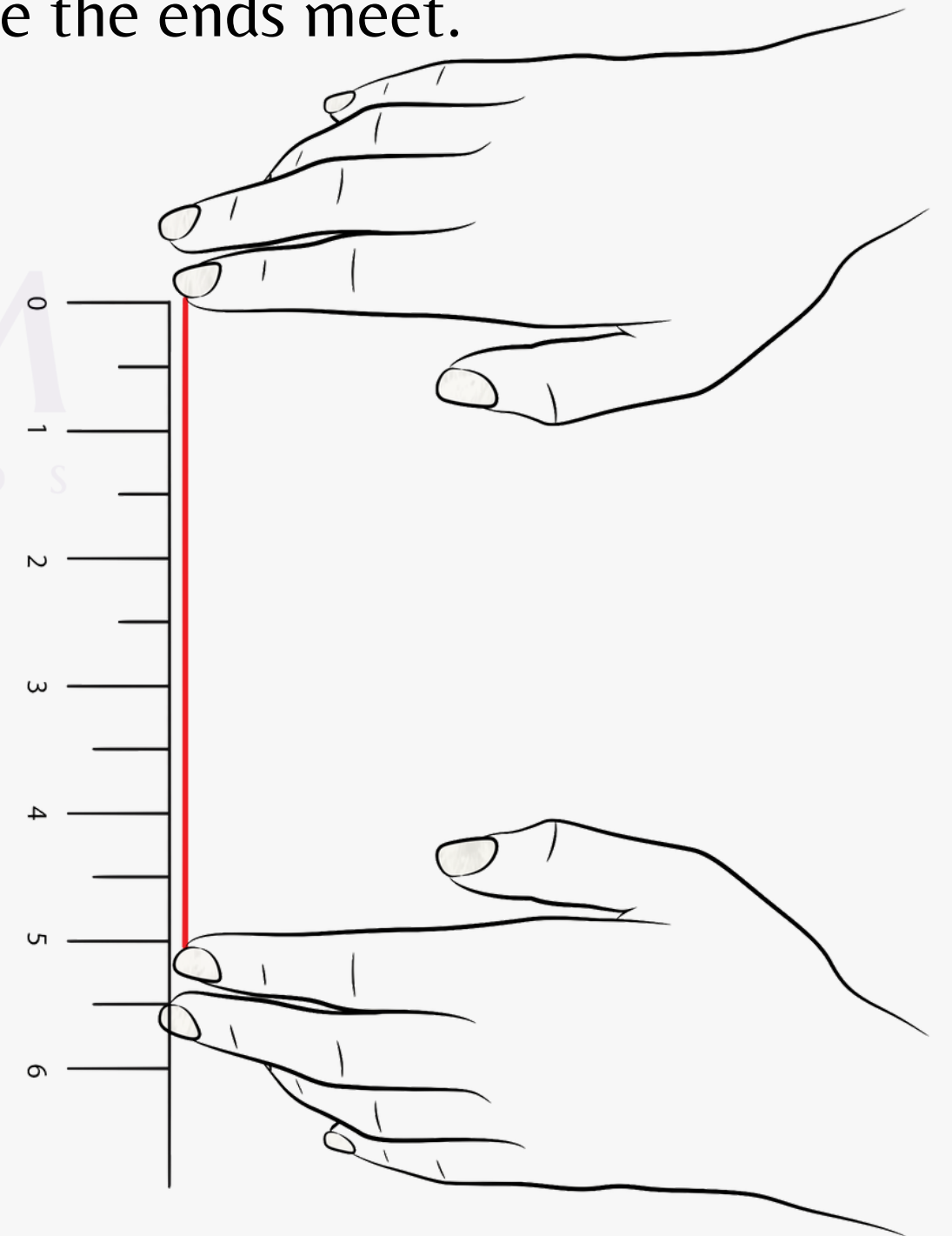

# Method 2: The hands on approach



- Get a measuring tape, string or strip of paper.
- Measure the inner diameter of the ring in Millimetres (mm)
- Using a pen or marker, mark where the ends meet.

- Lay your string or paper strip on a flat surface and use a ruler to measure the length in millimeters (mm). This is the circumference of your ring
- Use the chart given below to map this circumference to the diameter. The mapped diameter is your ring size. Use it to buy your chosen ring online at Tanishq.



# For Best Results

- Measure during the end of the day, as your finger may be at its largest.
- Avoid measuring your fingers when they are cold or damp.
- Measure finger size 3-4 times to avoid any errors.
